Title: Member Services Policy Update – Codes of Conduct

Summary: The SLSA General Code of Conduct has been endorsed as the standard Code of Conduct for

members in Queensland.

Date: 01.06.2018

The Member Services Committee conducted a review of the SLSQ Codes of Conduct policies against the SLSA General Member Code of Conduct. Subsequently, a recommendation was put forward to rescind the SLSQ suite of policies and adopt the SLSA General Code of Conduct.

The SLSQ Board has rescinded the following five policies ( 9 May 2018 ):

- MS07 Code of Conduct Admin-Directors-Officers
- MS08 Code of Conduct Coaches-Officials
- MS09 Code of Conduct Members
- MS10 Code of Conduct Team Manager-Age Manager-Chaperone
- MS11 Code of Conduct Youth Leader.

SLSQ members will now be bound the General Code of Conduct as per the SLSA Member Protection Policy - 6.05 Appendices.

## Why is this important?

Conduct and behaviour underpin organisational culture. Organisations that have a positive culture generally flourish and bring a huge amount of value to their community. A code of conduct can assist to create a positive culture by outlining expected standards of behavior for all involved in surf lifesaving.

Each member must commit to observing the General Code of Conduct and surf lifesaving entities may consider a failure to observe the Codes as misconduct, and may take appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with relevant rules and regulations including the SLSA Member Protection Policy - 6.05.

There are many ways that members receive the Code of Conduct, some suggestions include: displaying on the club notice board, printing in member welcome packs, adding to club newsletters, distributing during any formal inductions, or posting on club websites.
